

## **Placement for Success Prerequisites for Fall 2009**

- ✓ **E** (English) indicates an ACT English composition threshold score of 18, or its equivalent, that must be met prior to taking the designated course; i.e., ready to take EN 101 Rhetoric and Composition, ACT of 18, COMPASS of 69, or a minimum grade of "C" in EN 100 College Writing Skills.
- ✓ **M** (Math) indicates an ACT math threshold of 17, or its equivalent, that must be met prior to taking the designated course; i.e., ready to take MA 100 Basic Algebra, ACT of 17, COMPASS Pre Algebra of 41, or a minimum grade of "C" in MA 090 Pre Algebra.
- ✓ **R** (Reading) indicates an ACT reading threshold of 18, or its equivalent, that must be met prior to taking the designated course; i.e., ACT of 18, COMPASS of 78, or a minimum grade of "C" in EN 075 College Reading Skills.
