Program: Practical Nursing

Upon completion of this program, students will be able to:

1. Under the supervision of a registered nurse, practical nursing graduates will demonstrate use of the nursing process by focusing on the client as a person who is a unified whole in need of individualized nursing care.
2. Under the supervision of a registered nurse, practical nursing graduates will apply scientific nursing knowledge to clients in structured health care settings to promote meaningful human betterment.
3. Under the supervision of a registered nurse, practical nursing graduates will carry through with client centered care plans that are individualized and based on health pattern assessment that will lead to the maximum fulfillment of the client's potential.
4. Practical nursing graduates will assist the registered nurse in evaluating nursing care so that clients can achieve maximum participation in the life process.
5. Under the supervision of a registered nurse, practical nursing graduates will apply the areas of nursing service needed by the client in a structured health care environment.
6. Under the supervision of a registered nurse, practical nursing graduates will demonstrate the ability to communicate with the client and others by translation of knowledge into effective service.
7. Under the supervision of a registered nurse, practical nursing graduates will demonstrate an understanding of the purpose of nursing by providing care that promotes health and well-being for all clients in structured health care settings.

8. In structured health care settings, the practical nursing graduate will demonstrate the Practical Nurse role by ethically upholding the belief that nursing's goal is to serve humans throughout the life process.
9. Practical nursing graduates will recognize the need to continue to develop as a therapeutic agent by mobilizing and accessing educational resources throughout their practical nursing career.
