## Earn Your Degree

Bay College's Water Technology Program meets the needs of today's workforce by using the latest technology to deliver high-quality courses onsite and online.

The Water Technology Certificate is intended to train entry-level water, wastewater or industrial operators for jobs with municipalities and industries involved with control and prevention of water pollution.

The Water Resource Management Program is designed to provide specialized training in water and wastewater treatment theory and application to both entry-level personnel and those already in the field.

The Water Resource Management 1 + 1 degree is designed for students who have completed a basic college curriculum in science, then transfer to Bay College to take specialized courses in Water Technology. Associate in Applied Science in Water Resource Management degree graduates are immediately eligible for certification and entrance into the water/wastewater treatment industry.
