Why Nursing?

The Nursing program at Bay College prepares students to demonstrate entry-level competencies as registered nurses. Utilizing a concept-based framework, major concepts are introduced in the first semester and then linked throughout the program. Students will receive supervised clinical experiences in hospitals and long-term care facilities, and have the opportunity to learn in a cutting-edge simulation lab. Graduates will meet the educational requirements to take the National Council Licensure Examination for Registered Nursing (NCLEX-RN).
